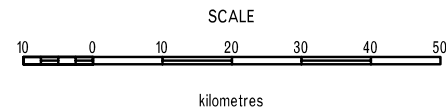


NOTE- This map should be used and interpreted with reference to the accompanying notes. It is a representation of groundwater availability and may not give a precise indication at any particular point.
